A Message from Pastor

“Turn from Sin.”

It is a dramatic scene in today’s Gospel: Jesus preaching from inside a house and a man lowered down in front of him. Our homes are not constructed with removable roof tiles, but even in a house like that, it would still be a show-stopping event. Think of how desperate and how committed they were to have Jesus heal the paralytic.

Even though we do not make the same connection of illness as a punishment for sin, we recognize that sin is an illness in itself—one that is in need of healing.

Today's readings seems like it is a beautiful prequel to Lent. The Lord tells us in Isaiah “See, I am doing something new!” Today is all about forgiveness of sins, and while today’s liturgy surely stands on its own, one could also use this as an opportunity to do some reflecting on our own need this Lent for forgiveness of sins and returning to God.

The Gospel dramatically reminds us that we are healed from sin when we come to Jesus. But we must take that initiative. We must begin the process of returning to the Lord. As Lent begins this week, we again have that opportunity to seek God’s mercy as a whole community of faith.

Fasting & Abstinence during Lent

Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2012 and Good Friday, April 6, 2012, are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence.



Fasting is to be observed by all, 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

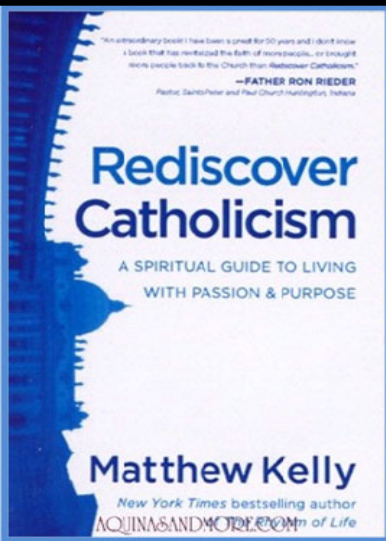
Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

Fasting allows us to be in unity with the millions of children and adults who are starving in our world. **Over 925 million people are hungry in our world today.** www.worldhunger.org
