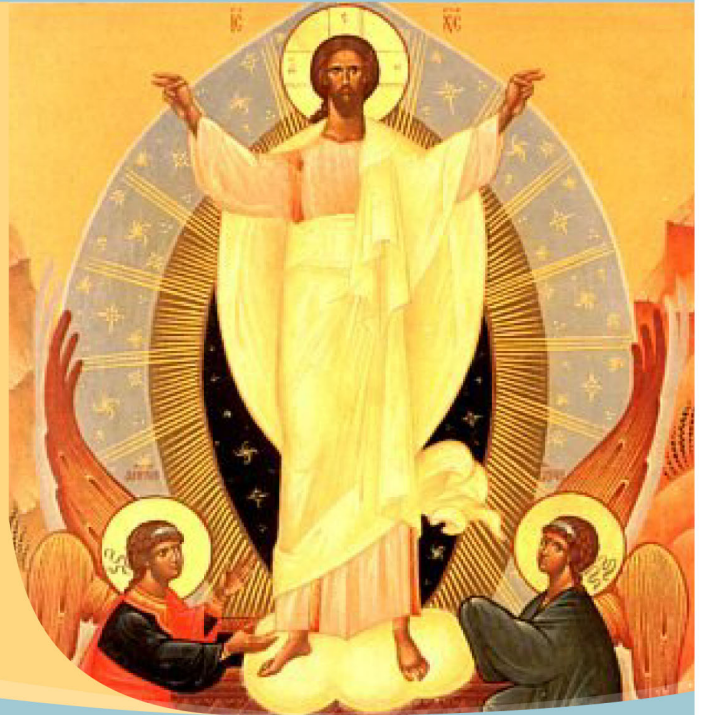

## Christian STEWARDSHIP

**"... I will ask my Father and He will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of Truth ..."**  
**John 14:15-21**

Today's Gospel continues with the *Last Supper Discourse*. Jesus leaves no room for ambiguity: "If you love me you will keep my commandments." For his part, Jesus promises, "I will ask the Father and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees him nor knows him." Our God created us; keeps us in existence; lived like us; died for us; rose from the dead as our guarantee of eternal life; and is with us always. Jesus is the model of Stewardship. As the popular song proclaims, *Our God is an Awesome God. He reigns from heaven above, with wisdom, power and might. Our God is an Awesome God.* How can we respond to such an *Awesome God*? Our response is to acknowledge, accept, develop and use all that God created us to be *for our benefit and enjoyment, and for the benefit and enjoyment of others*. If we listen carefully, we may be able to hear Jesus shout, "That would be awesome!"
